

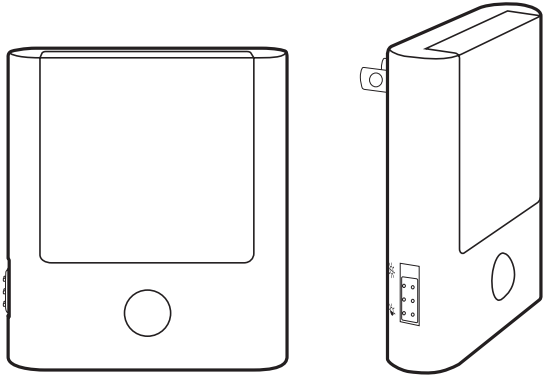

Operation

Night Light

There are 2 options to set up the night light:

1. **AUTO-DIMMING:** Set the switch to ☀️ (Fig. 1). The night light will turn on at full brightness for 25 seconds when motion is detected in low ambient light conditions. It will then auto-adjust to a lower brightness if the sensor does not detect further motion.
2. **MOTION SENSING:** Set the switch to 🌙 (Fig. 2). The night light will turn on when motion is detected in low ambient light conditions. It will automatically turn off after 25 seconds if motion is not detected or when there is sufficient ambient light.

Power Failure Mode

When there is a power outage, the white LED (6000k) will turn on at low brightness for 25 seconds, regardless of the selected light mode. After 25 seconds, it will operate in the selected mode using the white LED (6000k).

Charging the Night Light

Plug the Rechargeable Power Failure Night Light into a wall socket, upright or downfacing. (Fig. 3, Fig. 4)

Charging will stop automatically when the battery is fully charged.

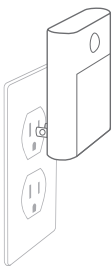

Troubleshooting

Problem	Possible Causes & Solutions
The light does not turn on.	The light will turn on only when there is a lack of ambient light. Relocate the light.
	The light is plugged into an outlet which is controlled by a wall switch. Make sure the wall switch is always on or plug the light into an outlet which is not controlled by a wall switch.
	The sensor is aiming at a wrong direction. Relocate the light.
The light does not turn off.	The light mode is set to auto-dimming. It will stay on when there is a lack of ambient light. Set the light mode to motion sensing.
	The motion sensor may be picking up a heat source, such as an air vent. Relocate the light.
The light does not turn on during power failure.	It will then turn off if there is sufficient ambient light or when the night light is set to motion sensing mode.
The light keeps turning on and off .	The light is near a reflective surface. The motion sensor is triggered by the heat that is being reflected from the light itself or from other objects. Remove the reflective materials or relocate the light.
	The motion sensor may be picking up a heat source, such as an air vent. Relocate the light.
	Photo sensor is not calibrated properly. Unplug the light and install it during daytime when there is adequate ambient light.
